It is fundamentally a disease of tissue growth regulation accounting for 25% of all the deaths in humans presently. The majority of cancers, some 90–95% of cases, are due to environmental factors. The remaining 5–10% are due to inherited genetics. Environmental, as used by cancer researchers, means any cause that is not inherited genetically, such as lifestyle, economic and behavioral factors and not merely pollution. Common environmental factors that contribute to cancer death include tobacco (25–30%), diet and obesity (30–35%), infections (15–20%), radiation (both ionizing and non-ionizing, up to 10%), stress, lack of physical activity and environmental pollutants.

It is considered as an adversary of modernization and advanced pattern of socio-cultural life dominated by Western medicine. Multidisciplinary scientific investigations are making best efforts to combat this disease, but the sure-shot, perfect cure is yet to be brought into world medicine. Recently, a greater emphasis has been given towards the researches on complementary and alternative medicine that deals with cancer management.

Ayurvedic classics describe cancer as inflammatory or non-inflammatory swelling and mention them as either Granthi or Arbuda. Fundamental Ayurvedic classification of neoplasm depends on various clinical symptoms in relation to Tridoshas. Any practical solution in combating this dreadful disease is of paramount importance. An alternative solution to western medicine embodied with severe side effects is the use of medicinal plant preparations to arrest the insidious nature of the disease.

Ayurveda, a traditional Indian medicine of plant drugs has been successful from very early times in using these natural drugs and preventing or suppressing various tumors using various lines of treatment. Many herbs have been evaluated in clinical studies and are currently being investigated phytochemically to understand their tumouricidal actions against various cancers. An integrated approach is needed to manage cancer using the growing body of knowledge gained through scientific developments. This traditional Indian medicine with its evolution through centuries has always fascinated practitioners and researchers for its applications in cancer treatment on a scientifically proven research background.

The broad aim of this seminar is to provide a general outline on descriptions of cancers and their management from an Ayurvedic practitioners' perspective underlying its scientific principles involved in treating these conditions with the use of natural products. It is being organized with an intention to raise awareness and encourage implementation of Ayurvedic therapies for combating cancer and suggesting an integrated approach in tumor management and treatment as a scientifically driven one and not simply unconventional.
