Earlier Vijayawada was named as Bezawada as story says- the name refers to Goddess krishnaveni who requested Arjuna to make a passage through the Indrakiladri hills for her to merge into Bay of Bengal. This passage refers to Bejjam which means a hole through the mountain. Hence the place came to be known as Bezawada. Later it is named as Vijayawada since it is a place of victory. South of the city once flourished with Buddism by Sidda Nagarjuna at Vundavalli caves. World famous cloth weavers village Mangalagiri blessed with the presence of lord Narasimha where jaggery syrup offered as prasada. Besides being a religious center it is the center for Andhra culture, famous for Kuchupudinrithyam of nearby village of Kuchipudi, wooden toys of Kondapalli village, another world famous kalankari block printing place along with sangam of river Krishna with Bay of Bengal in the east of the city

Great amusement places like, Bhavani Islands, Haailands, Gandhi hills, Berm park, Bapu Museum, Goutham Buddha's Holy Aura at AMARAVATHI, Dead Volcano at Mangalagiri. NTPC power grid, Prakasam barrage etc are located at Vijayawada.
